



On July 12, 2016, the Calouste Gulbenkian Hall of the Hayartun Center at the Armenian Diocese in Georgia hosted a meeting with Armenian modern poetess of Georgia, translator, the Head of the “Vrastan” Newsletter (“Georgia”) Subscription and Delivery Service, a member of the “Vernatun” Union of Armenian Writers of Georgia, the president of NGO “Kamurj” for the Armenian-Georgian Literary Relations, the Head of Armenian Department at the Union of Writers of Georgia – Anahit Bostanjyan.
