



Within the framework of cooperation between Information Center on NATO and EU and the Youth Department of the Armenian Diocese in Georgia (Director: Valery Badalyan), on October 12, 2016, the visit of young Armenian activists to the Information Center, particularly the new premises of the Information Center, which were inaugurated during an official visit in Georgia of NATO Secretary General, Jens Stoltenberg, was organized.
