



On the 22nd of June, in Calouste Gulbenkian Hall of the "Hayartun" Center of the Diocese of the Armenian Apostolic Church in Georgia a personal photo exhibition of Tbilisi Public School № 98 student, 15-year-old Edward Badoyan, was opened. It was initiated by the Union of Armenian Artists of Georgia
